2018 Year 10 half-yearly exams: information for students

- Full winter school uniform is to be worn.
- You are expected to bring all required equipment (pens, stapler, tissues, water, calculators etc) in a clear plastic container. There is no borrowing of equipment during an examination.
- No extra time is given if you are late for an examination.
- Meet in Carroll Court before each exam.
- You are expected to behave in a manner appropriate to a formal examination setting, i.e. making a serious attempt at all parts of the examination, remaining silent in exam rooms, not copying another student's work and not doodling or drawing graffiti on examination papers.
- During periods where you do not have a scheduled examination you have the opportunity for private study.
- If you are absent on the day of an examination due to illness or misadventure your parent/carer is to let the college know (call Mr Matthews or Mrs McArdle). An **Illness/Misadventure form** is to be completed and all necessary documentation, such as medical certificates attached and given to the relevant Leader of Learning on return to school. A green Illness/Misadventure form can be found in your assessment handbook or you may collect one from the Student Services office.
- You should expect to sit any missed exams, where possible, at a mutually agreed time.
Arrangements about any missed examinations are to be made with the Leader of Learning for the subject in the first instance.
- You may not leave exams early.
- **Mobile phones and internet wrist watches must not be taken into exam rooms so you should leave them locked in your locker. If you are found to have a phone in the exam room then you receive will zero marks (as per the 2018 college assessment policy).**
