Accounts will show annual fees payable in full at the start of the year, in three instalments or monthly, fortnightly or weekly as indicated on your Family Registration Form for 2017.

EXCURSIONS & CERTIFICATE COURSES

All general excursions for Years 7 and 8 are included in the Education Services Fee except extra curricular activities such as choir etc. Excursions for Years 9 to 12 relating to courses have been included in the Course Fee or will be shown on your account as a separate line combining all excursions for the year for that subject. All other general excursions for 9 to 12 for the whole year have been included in the Education Services Fee.

Years 10 and 11 will undertake a First Aid course – this course will be billed on your fees. If your daughter already holds a current First Aid certificate completed through a registered agency please provide the college with a copy of this certificate and this fee will be removed from your account.

There may be some excursions taking place where all information is not available at the time of billing. This may require your daughter to bring money in an envelope to the Finance Office. All money should be clearly marked with student's name, homeroom and purpose. Some workbooks for particular courses may also be included on the account.

FAMILY REGISTRATION FORM

Sibling Discounts are available on application for 2nd and subsequent students attending Diocesan Catholic Schools in the Broken Bay Diocese, St Edwards College and systemic schools in Parramatta, Sydney and Wollongong. Family Registration Forms have been distributed and should now have been returned to the College.

INFORMATION ON PAYMENT OF FEES

Our preferred method for payment of school fees is BPay, however, payment may be made by cash, EFTPOS, VISA or MASTERCARD.

FEES ARE EXPECTED TO BE PAID PROMPTLY

It is expected that fees will be paid as per the schedule which appears at the bottom of your fee statement. Your schedule is raised as per your nominated payment choice on your Family Registration Form. Please do not wait for a reminder notice before paying your fees. Statements will be emailed out at the beginning of each month and this will show any payments made by you during this period. Please check your statement carefully and inform the College as soon as possible if there are any anomalies.

FEE SUPPORT

We understand that each family faces different financial situations. We are happy to work with you to ensure fees are manageable. If you have any concerns with fees and fee payments please contact the Finance Office to discuss payment plan options. In the case of genuine financial hardship fee relief can be discussed. All discussions in relation to fees are treated with the highest confidentiality, discussed only with the College Principal and the Business Manager.
